DAY / PACKAGE TOURS

GOLF

Machrie Golf Course on Islay and the world famous Machrihanish Golf Club in Kintyre are just two of the challenging links courses offered on the Scottish side - with Royal Portrush, Ballycastle and Portstewart welcoming visitors to the Irish side.

NORTH ANTRIM COAST

A journey of legends and history merge all along this coastal trip. Stop off below the Carrick-A-Rede Rope Bridge; visit the windswept Torr Head and recall the story of The Children Of Lir; admire Dunluce Castle clinging fast on to a dramatic clifftop - a silent reminder of ancient times.

GIANTS CAUSEWAY BY SEA

Visit the site of the world famous Giant's Causeway whose six-sided basalt columns were formed not as the geologists say by volcanic eruptions, but rather as the result of the romantic notions of giant Finn McCool, who wished to build a path to take up a challenge from Benandonner. Rathlin Island

Join us on a fantastic voyage round the Rathlin coastline. On the towering basalt and chalk cliffs at the West Light be amazed by the thousands of guillemots and kittiwakes while on the offshore stacks are razor bills, fulmars and puffins. Atop the soaring cliffs catch a glimpse of the "upside down" lighthouse, or marvel at the depth and crystal clarity of the sea. Onwards to the East Lighthouse, from which area Marconi made the first commercial radio transmission in 1898. In the cliff face below look out for Bruce's cave, where the Scottish King took inspiration from a spider. On past the aptly named Smugglers Cove, round the Rue Point and head for picturesque Church Bay. Pause to admire the basking seals or disembark and sample some Island hospitality.



Sanda Island

50 minutes from Ballycastle lies the privately owned island of Sanda. Be met by the Laird and discover Scotland's 4th official bird sanctuary. Sanda has a wide range of natural beauty to visit, explore and enjoy. Then a meal and wine with the Laird in the Bar.



Gigha

Famous for the Gardens of Achamore, excellent hotel, Bed and Breakfast and Self Catering accommodation.

Eco Trips

Eco trips including bird watching, and sea angling; whale; and seal watching are also to be made available.

There is a colony of seals numbering over 100 at the Rue Light House on Rathlin Island. These are so curious that care has to be taken not to disturb them too much when they are surrounding the boats.

Bird Watching

Sea birds numbered in their thousands, are to be found at the Bull Lighthouse (the only 'upside down' lighthouse in the UK). They include puffins, razorbills and kittiwakes.
